MOVING DAY PREP

Packing supplies – boxes, tape Organise moving company and and markers

Folder with warranties and manuals Moving and contents insurance

Confirm moving in/moving out

information

timings

for new owners

Give landlord notice on moving

DECLUTTER YOUR STUFF

Sort cupboards, drawers, garages Reserve storage in new home and sheds

Throw out, donate or sell items

Ask friends for help

Check when things expire

Book leave off work

Plan meals to use up food

PACKING AND STORAGE

Clearly label valuables

Inform moving company of any fragile goods

Label each box clearly with designated room

Scan rooms for hidden items

Sort a 'day of move' box with essentials

Inform moving company of your packing and unloading process

Pack infrequently used items

ahead of time



CLEANING

Clean the stove Disconnect washing machine

Defrost fridge/freezer See to repairs or fixes needed ahead of time

Tidy yard Hire cleaner for moving day

Tidy shed Disconnect dishwasher

Tidy roof gutters

CHILDREN AND SCHOOLS

Research new schools Notify old school about end date

Inquire and set up introductions

Notify new school about transfer date

DAY OF MOVE

Arrange care for your kids and Check smoke alarms

pets

Charge your mobile phone Check all lights are switched off

Do a final meter reading for electricity/gas – take a photo

Check all windows and doors are shut and locked

Switch off the hot water cylinder

AFTER MOVE DAY

Inform your insurance of anything that was lost or damaged during the move

If you own, have spare keys cut

Get your kids and pets familiar with their new neighborhood

Greet your new neighbours
